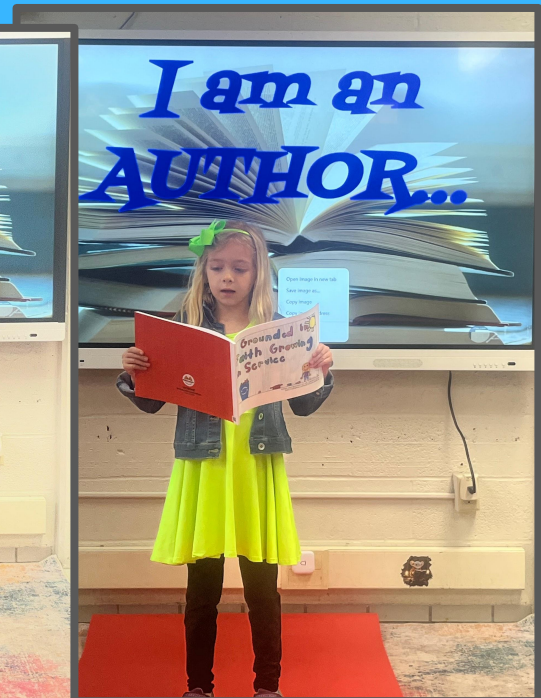
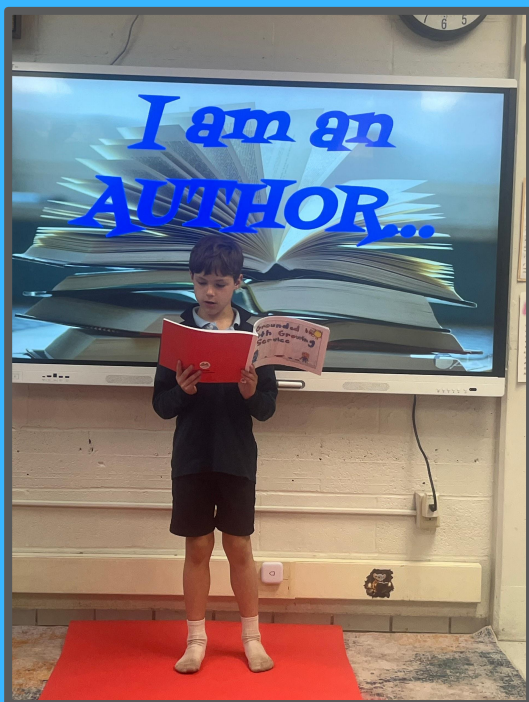
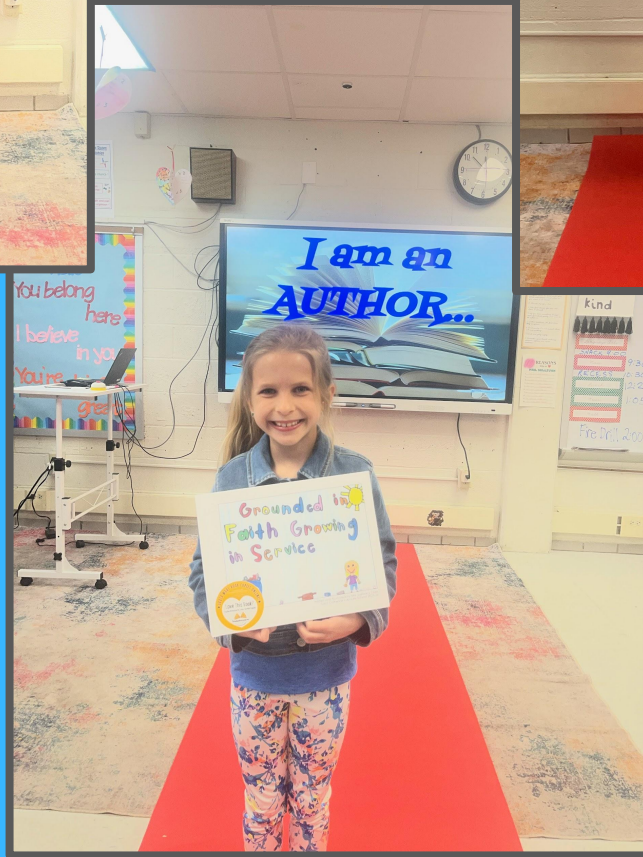
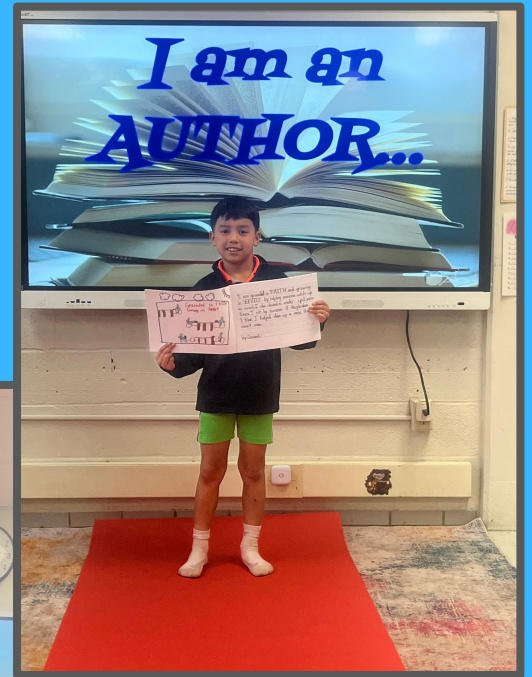
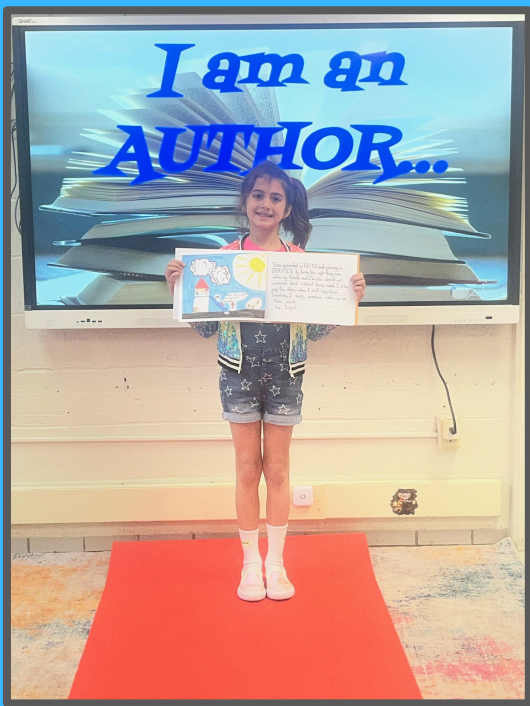
Our 7th graders celebrated the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral Basilica and the entire school enjoyed a beautiful prayer service.
