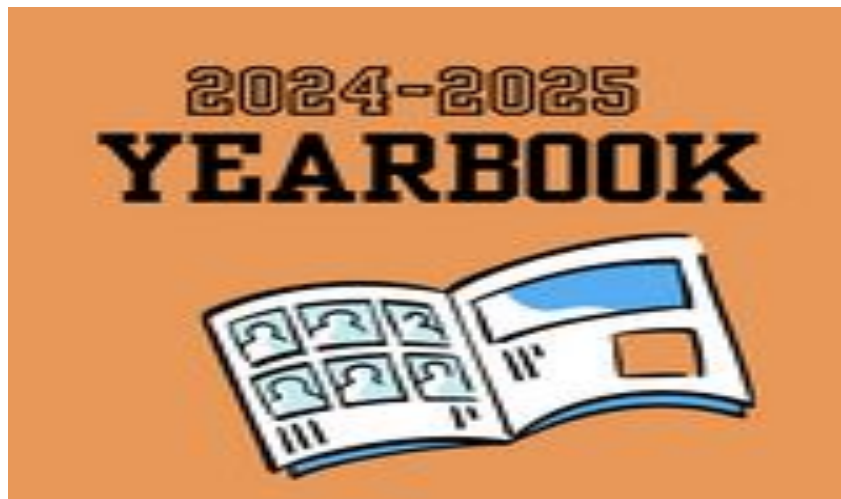


SCL Year Book for 2024-2025 Orders

Virtue for April: Service



Definition: Helping someone other than ourselves; either God or other people.

Mass: God calls us to serve Him through worship, prayer, and living a life of virtue. We have the opportunity to do all of these when we participate fully in Mass.

School: We can serve one another when we help other people with their needs.

Home: Serving the people closest to us can sometimes be the most difficult, but it can also be the most meaningful.

How Can I Show This Virtue Today?

- **For teachers:** How can I model service for my students?
- **For students:** How can I help God or others before myself?

Remember: Serving others regularly helps us build perseverance in putting others first.

How We Show Service at Mass:

1. **Watch the servers, readers, and choir members closely.** Notice how they serve at Mass and follow their example.
2. **Respond during Mass.** We are serving God when we join with others in saying the responses and singing.
3. **Listen attentively to Father's homily.** The homily provides clearer direction on how you can serve God and others in the circumstances of your life.
4. **During the Eucharistic Prayer, offer yourself, along with Jesus, to the Father's will.** We are serving God when we trust God and embrace His will in all things.
5. **As we leave Mass, we are called to love and serve the Lord.** Let the grace that you have received at Mass help you serve God and others in your life.

Conversation Starters & Journaling Prompts

Has serving others ever been difficult for you? What was one way that you helped someone else? How did you grow through the experience?

What is one thing that someone else has done for you? Were you thankful for their service?

Think of a family member or someone else close to you. What do they need? How can you help them?
