

Virtue for March: Temperance



Definition: Enjoying things in a proper, balanced way.

Mass: Remembering that at Mass, we are feeding our soul with time with Jesus.

School: Using our independent work time to focus on completing our assignments, and playing at the appropriate time.

Home: Getting plenty of sleep, healthy food, and fresh air, and moderating screen time.

Virtue Language:

How can I work this virtue into my language?

- "I like how (Name) is showing temperance by..."
- "I can practice temperance by eating healthy foods regularly and sweets rarely."
- "I'm sorry I can't _____, I have to _____."

Remember: Temperance helps us balance wants and needs and helps us grow in obedience.

Showing Temperance at Mass:

1. **Walk into church silently and reverently.** Set aside conversations with your friends, and turn your focus fully to God.
2. **Spend the quiet time before Mass speaking to God in your heart.** Ask the Lord to help you collect your mind and give him your all during Mass.
3. **Listen to God speak to you in the readings.** Listen for examples of the ways others sought the appropriate balance in their lives.
4. **Say or sing the responses meaningfully.** Make your responses and songs appropriate gifts to God and pay special attention to God while we give those gifts.
5. **When distracted, quietly redirect yourself back to prayer.** We sometimes find ourselves distracted, but bringing our mind back to God shows our temperance.
6. **Receive the Eucharist properly.** Bow fully at the waist. Hold your hands flat like a paten, chest high, one supporting the other. Say "Amen" clearly, and reverently receive Jesus in the Eucharist.

Conversation Starters & Journaling Prompts

In what ways was the saint from this month's reading an example of temperance?

Reflect on the activities I engage in regularly, identifying which I should spend more time doing, and which less time.

How can I continue to grow in temperance?
